
I Peter 2:11-14 says, "Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, Glorify God in the day of visitation. Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme; or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that seek to do well."

From these verses, we learn the principle of striving to keep a testimony that is above reproach for sake of the fact that we represent Christ to the Lost. As part of that principle, we are told to "submit to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake". It is clear from the context, that Peter has legal ordinances in mind. Requiring teenagers to commit to adhere to our policy manual is not intended to discourage anyone from working in the ministry at Faith. We are excited to mobilize and encourage any who is trustworthy and willing to serve in the ministry. We do, however, have a responsibility to parents and to the law to maintain certain guidelines in our ministries.

I hope that as you read over and fill out this form you will seek to understand the biblical and legal requirements that make it necessary. By signing your name to this form, you are stating that you have read the Youth Ministries Policies, that you understand them and their importance, and are committing to adhere to them entirely.
